A GROUP, A HISTORY

In 1942

Jean-Jacques VERNAZZA founded the Medtrans port forwarding company, which at the time consisted of 4 employees. At the end of 1942, with the acquisition of a small stevedoring facility to complement his business, MEDIACO ACCONAGE was born.

The 509

The acquisition of a Nordest carrier crane was the first step towards the purchase of other port cranes.

At the end of 1972

Christian-Jacques VERNAZZA founded Mediaco Levage. He was very attached to the city of Marseille, and heavily involved in the development of the local economy and innovative industrial projects. He was keen to keep the Group's head office here.

Mediaco began its lifting business with the acquisition of the most high-performance equipment of the time. A Grove TM800, the world's most powerful telescopic boom crane in 1973.

Gradually, the fleet shifted from lattice cranes to telescopic cranes, enabling Mediaco Levage to rapidly expand its reputation in France.

Christian-Jacques VERNAZZA has integrated his children Annabelle, Alexandre-Jacques and Rodolphe into the family group.

Mediaco also set about diversifying its activities, notably into bulk liquid storage, oil production and logistics.

In 2006

Alexandre-Jacques VERNAZZA joined the Mediaco Group. In 2008, he became Operations Manager for Mediaco Levage, then Managing Director in 2011. He succeeded to the presidency of the family group in 2013

Early 2014

Mediaco decides to open 2 branches in Germany (Kehl and Freibur).

Mediaco GmbH (Germany) 2021 has a fleet of 50 machines, including 30 cranes from 50 to 400T, spread over 4 branches (Stuttgrat, Kehl, Rheinau, Karlsruhe).

End of 2016

Mediaco consolidates its position as national No. 1 through the acquisition of Groupe SMMI (Grenoble, Lyon, Valence and Annecy), 4 agencies, 50 cranes and 80 people, positioning the Mediaco Group as regional leader in the Rhône-Alpes region.

2017

The Mediaco Group acquires one of the largest cranes on the European market and the largest and most powerful crane in France (670T at 21m outreach): an LG1750 (lattice crane on mobile carriers with 750T capacity), capable of handling all wind turbine erections (147T at 120m) as well as the largest national contracts, including the Grand Paris construction sites. To date, Mediaco Maxilift has 15 cranes over 500 tonnes in operation throughout France.

2019

Mediaco acquires Groupe Altead, the 3rd largest lifting company in France, with 190 cranes, 500 employees and 15 branches.

This acquisition enables the group to increase its fleet of equipment and its national presence, and demonstrates the family-owned group's determination to grow and develop.

5050

MEDIACO acquires the Chieusse Levage group, with its 37 machines,


including 14 cranes ranging from 30 to 130 tons, distributed across 4 agencies: Les Arcs [83], Fréjus [83], Grimaud [83], and Nice [06], which becomes MEDIACO CENTRE VAR. Chieusse Levage was established by the Chieusse family in 1975. This acquisition allows the group to strengthen its network of agencies and its presence in the Gulf of Saint-Tropez and Var, consolidating its position as a leader in the Southern region.

The company SE LEVAGE, based in Haute-Savoie, and its 5 agencies: Frangy, Annecy, Chambéry, Lyon, and Orléans, join the MEDIACO group. The Heavy Lifting department, based in Haute-Savoie and Orleans, has 5 cranes from 500T to 800T that will be integrated into MEDIACO MAXILIFT. SE LEVAGE SWISS, now MEDIACO SWISS, also allows the Mediaco group to establish itself in Switzerland from 2021.

The integration of SE LEVAGE allows the Marseille-based family group to strengthen its regional positions with a network of more than 15 agencies in Rhône-Alpes out of the group's 90 national agencies.

The Mediaco Group achieves a turnover of €450 million and records an increase of +€200 million over the last 7 years for the lifting activity (Revenue in 2015: €156 million / Revenue in 2022: €362 million).

Mediaco now boasts **900 cranes** ranging from **35 to 800 tons, 90** branches and **2,300 employees**, making it the number-one national and number-three European crane group.

MEDIACO LEVAGE

Through its network of 90 local agencies and its teams of professionals, the MEDIACO group offers two types of services governed by the general conditions of the UFL (Union Française du Levage).

Rental of equipment, cranes and trucks

- The customer renting lifting equipment is solely responsible for the smooth running of operations. He/she appoints a foreman who is responsible for the proper execution of lifting operations, and for giving instructions to the crane driver.
- A crane made available with a crane driver placed under the effective authority of the hirer, who has complete control over operations and to whom the subordination link is transferred. The hirer becomes responsible for the operating personnel.

Service delivery

Lifting and transport

MEDIACO LEVAGE takes charge of the lifting to be carried out, and assumes control and responsibility for the lifting operation.

In addition to the equipment and its driver, MEDIACO provides in this contract:

- A foreman who directs and supervises the lifting operation.
- Site surveys with certificate of suitability.


- Assembly and installation of new equipment
- Handling of machine tools and boilers
- Dismantling and deconstruction, including waste disposal
- Installation or transfer of machines and production
- Design and implementation studies for industrial projects.







The design office is based at MEDIACO Group headquarters. It draws up all studies, calculations, plans, expert appraisals and technical follow-up for the Group's projects, to carry out global lifting and handling operations in all sectors of activity (petrochemicals, chemicals, construction, industry, civil engineering, nuclear, energy). All studies are carried out using IT tools, by a highly mobile team that backs up the experience and skills of our field teams, while complying with safety regulations.





MEDIACO has a fleet of 900 cranes from 35 to 800 T, spread across our 90 branches, available 24 hours a day, and capable of all kinds of lifting work:

- High-speed self-propelled cranes from 35 to 800 T
- Slow self-propelled cranes from 30 to 100 T

- Telescopic crawler cranes from 50 to 220 T






